



Nominations are open for the 2025 AHOU Hall of Fame!

AHOU is dedicated to recognizing members who have consistently advanced the underwriting profession and have exemplified the Guiding Principles for the Underwriter. The Hall of Fame will honor and publicly recognize the achievements of our outstanding members who have been nominated by their peers.

Only AHOU members are permitted to nominate individuals for the AHOU Hall of Fame. Members may only nominate one person per year. Let's honor those who have been role models for our profession!

Nominee Qualifications:

- Current or past AHOU member. If currently retired from the profession, an active membership may not be required.
- An FALU designation.
- Documented contributions to the underwriting profession, including, but not limited to, 10 or more years of work history (some of which must have been as an Underwriter in the individual classification of mortality and/or morbidity risk). May have served as a mentor to many professionals in the business.
- Demonstrated contributions that have impacted the profession, i.e., research, new processes, knowledge sharing. Active involvement in new products, processes, and procedures for the advancement of the industry.
- Participation in AHOU, ALU, OTR, or a local or regional underwriting association, in a leadership or committee member position. Current members of the AHOU Executive Council or Program Committee are excluded from consideration.
- Volunteer work for the profession, e.g., as an author for publications/articles or as industry speaker; with vendors and reinsurers for advancement of ideas and learning; with regional and local organizations to further strengthen their presence.
- Personal achievements that demonstrate leadership and commitment to the Guiding Principles for the Underwriter.
