

AHOU HALL OF FAME

NOW ACCEPTING NOMINATIONS



The AHOU Hall of Fame is designed to recognize members who have consistently been visible leaders in the underwriting profession exemplified the Guiding Principles for the Underwriter throughout their careers, and demonstrated a meaningful contribution to the profession. The AHOU Hall of Fame will honor and publicly record the achievements of our outstanding members, nominated by their peers. Qualifications for Nominees for the AHOU Hall of Fame:

- Current or past AHOU member. If currently retired from the profession an active membership may not be required.
- Documented contributions to the underwriting profession, including, but not limited to, 10 or more years work history (some of which must have been as an Underwriter in the individual classification of mortality and/or morbidity risk). May have served as a mentor to many professionals in the business.
- Demonstrated contributions that have impacted the profession – research, new processes, knowledge sharing. Active involvement in new products, processes and procedure for the advancement of the industry.
- Participation in AHOU, ALU, OTR, local or regional underwriting association, etc. in a leadership or committee member position. Cannot currently be a member of the AHOU Executive Council or Program Committee for consideration.
- Volunteer work for the profession, for example, as an author for publications/articles or as industry speaker, with vendors and reinsurers for advancement of ideas and learning, with regional and local organizations to further strengthen their presence.
- Personal achievements that demonstrate leadership and commitment to the Guiding Principles for the Underwriter.

The Hall of Fame honorees will be selected from candidates nominated by members of AHOU.

- Nomination ballot/form will be developed by the AHOU Past President annually in the November-January timeframe.
- The call for nominations will be sent to the membership and remain open for a minimum of 30 days and a maximum of 60 days.
- Nominations will be vetted by the Nomination Committee which consists of AHOU President, AHOU Executive Vice President, AHOU Past President and (2) AHOU Members at Large.
- A maximum of 3 Hall of Fame Candidates will be selected annually.

- Hall of Fame honorees selected are notified by the Past President of their selection and invited to the Annual Conference for presentation of their award. A complimentary Annual Meeting Registration is provided. Honorees are responsible for travel and hotel accommodations.
- Honorees are presented with a Hall of Fame Award. They are recognized through a variety of means including but not limited to introduction at the Annual Meeting, AHOU press release, in an OTR article, through social media outlets and all Hall of Fame honorees are maintained within the AHOU website.
