

TEN DAYS TO DISCOVER THE BIBLE

The following can be used either as a ten-day reading schedule for personal use or as ten weekly Bible studies for personal or group study. One possible way to use it would be to:

1. Spend a short time in prayer to open to the Lord.
2. Read through the Bible reading.
3. Go back through the chapter, reading the suggested footnotes and their associated verses. It can be helpful to underline key words in the footnotes or make short notes in the margin or in a notebook.
4. Write a short summary of what you have enjoyed and/or share your enjoyment with others in your group.
