




# Adult Recognition Awards

### **COUNCIL AWARDS:**

One Person Can Make A Difference: To recognize the unique contribution of staff, volunteers or funders who do their best to ensure that the word "childhood" will stir happy memories for today's youth.

Dorothy Brown North Star Award: Given to adult volunteers in recognition of their shining example of giving and service to the youth, staff and volunteers of the Council.

Helping, Sharing, Always Caring: Given in recognition and sincere appreciation of outstanding service on behalf of Camp Fire youth in our community.

Anita Lindner Award: Throughout her life, Anita was deeply committed to serving youth by doing whatever job needed to be done. This award, in her memory, is given to recognize excellence of service by example.

Certificate or Plaque of Appreciation: Given to individuals, groups or organizations for outstanding service both within and outside of Camp Fire.

Outstanding Volunteer Award: Given to youth, staff and volunteers in recognition of outstanding service on behalf of youth in our community.

Life Membership: Established to honor our pioneers of Camp Fire, who have given so freely of their time, talents and resources.

### **NATIONAL AWARDS:**

#### *For Leadership to Clubs*

Wakan: Given to registered members of club leadership teams for outstanding contributions to a club, providing creative programs, guidance and inspiration for three or more years.

Hiiteni: Given to recognize four or more years of extensive and innovative service to youth, which is recognized throughout the council.

#### *For Service to the Council*

Shawneguas Award: To recognize outstanding contributions within the whole area of service to clubs and leaders, such as training, program and club organization. Recipients must have been registered adult members of Camp Fire for at least three years.

Charlotte Joy Farnsworth Award: To recognize outstanding contributions to a region or large geographic section of a council in the area of broad overall administrative operations. Recipients must have been registered adult members of Camp Fire for at least three years.

Sebago Award: Given for outstanding contributions to camping and outdoor programs.

John Collier Award: Given to recognize outstanding contributions in the fields of business and finance.

Good News Award: Given to recognize significant contributions in the areas of advocacy, public relations and community relations through writing, art, public speaking, photography or media relations.

Ernest Thompson Seton Award: For contributions so outstanding that they have been felt throughout the entire council. Recipients must have been registered adult members of Camp Fire for four or more years.

Luther Halsey Gulick Award: Given for very special and outstanding council leadership over an extended period of time by giving visible and distinctive service toward harmonious growth and expansion of the council. This is considered the highest form of recognition in a local council and should be reserved for very special people.

#### *Special Awards*

Blue Ribbon Award: To thank volunteers, staff, donors, and friends who have given time or resources above and beyond the call of duty.

Heart Award: Given for outstanding service exceeding the expectations of the Council staff person's role.
