

Driving Rules Hondas @ Hallett

Rules are in place to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable and safe experience during this event.

1. Gates are open at 6:30am so early birds may walk, bicycle, or golf cart the track during the sunrise hour. You can also prepare by viewing the counterclockwise onboard lap on the Hallett website.
2. All Drivers will be required to bring completed TECH FORM and HELMET to check-in on first floor of tower BEFORE the 7:30am driver meeting.
3. ALL Drivers must attend the Drivers' Meeting at 7:30am. Grid stickers will be handed out at this meeting for track access. All **first time** Drivers **MUST** attend the High-Performance Driving Education classroom immediately following the ALL drivers meeting. Passing areas will be explained in the Drivers' Meeting and there will be a review of the flags used to communicate with you on track. 8:45 Ride around parade laps for any interested registered drivers. On track with **group 1** at 9:00 am. (Should be Advanced)
4. Penalty Rules:
 - Passing in unapproved areas will result in a Black Flag and the Driver will be required to come into the hot pits for a discussion with the Chief Steward.
 - Two (2) wheels off the track will result in a Black Flag and the Driver will be required to come into the hot pits for a discussion with the Chief Steward, unless deems to be a controlled track out of corner by safety worker.
 - Four (4) Wheels off the track or significant loss of control determined by Hallett personnel will result in a Black Flag and the Driver will be required to come into the hot pits for a discussion with the Chief Steward and may result in loss of Driving Privileges for the remainder of the session.
 - Two (2) Black Flags during a session will result in loss of driving privileges for the remainder of the session.
 - Three (3) Black flags for the day will result in loss of Event driving privileges and you will be asked to leave the track.
 - Aggressive driving will not be permitted. Anyone violating the rules of the high-speed driving school will be asked to leave.
5. Slower cars (Drivers) shall point faster cars around in established passing areas between BLUE PASSING CONES. Do not keep faster traffic behind you. The driver being passed should hold the line and slightly lift off throttle. It is up to the passing driver to make a safe pass, only one car at a time.
6. No passengers are allowed, except HMRC Instructors/Coaches. Instructors/Coaches will use flashing emergency lights if driving student car.

Remember while on track, you must keep all limbs inside the car, no hand-held cameras, no smoking, keep helmet on until you are in the pits, pay attention to the flags. Keep your **concentration level on** until you turn the key off. Many times, off-course excursions take place on the cool-off lap. After taking the checkered, drive half speed for that final lap to cool the brakes, tires, and engine.
