PRO COACH THING TO REMEMBER #1 We are Guests

Be polite, check in at the front desk and go

to your room as soon as possible.

- VISUALLY INSPECT the space and note the placement of furniture plus any potential hazards
- · CLEAN UP garbage and LEGO with the help of your students
- REPLACE furniture
- FINAL VISUAL INSPECTION should be done before leaving the room with the students

PRO COACH THING TO REMEMBER #2 Parents Pay the Bill

We are responsible for the safety and well-being of our students when they are in our care, and parents notice when you get it right...or wrong. Remember that the child's happiness is the most important thing in the parent's life.

- · CALL parents with progress reports twice each session
- TALK AFTER DISMISSAL about important issues
- · BE POSITIVE about partnering for solutions
- INCLUDE STUDENTS IN THE CONVERSATION
- · SAY SOMETHING GOOD before you tackle any issues

PRO COACH THING TO REMEMBER #3 First Impressions Last
