- MAKE examples of suggested LEGO builds and techniques
- · RESEARCH words and topics you are not familiar with
- · FIND more photo examples to help explain ideas in the lesson
- · PLAN a fun physical or trivia game related to the topic



- · Use a tool like a bell or penny whistle to get attention
- · Say in a loud voice: "Quiet please in 5...4...3...2...1. Thank you!"
- · Stay positive and reward students who respond
- · Ask them to raise a hand to help you with PRO COACH TIP #3!



- · Let students participate in setting rules for the club.
- · Say: "Raise a hand if you have a good rule for our club."
- Stay positive and reward students who respond
- · Adjust and combine rules as needed, but reward all participants.
- · Be sure that 'Have fun' makes it on to the list



- Create teams
- · Encourage sportsman-like behavior
- Maximize on student competitive behavior
- · Reward the effort, not the product
- · Keep track of rewards so in the end everyone wins (and loses)



- · Don't delay. Deal with it right away!
- With competition will come conflict
- · Be ready to help students with calming techniques
- · Be ready to help students with conflict resolution
- Be fair



- Keep track of time
- Tell students how much time is left at least 3 times
- · Set limits on share time with a timer
- · Leave plenty of time for clean up and (hopefully) a game!



- Make the clean up process a competition between teams, with you, or between individuals
- · Whatever you do the goal is the same
  - No LEGO on the floor
  - Kids are in line



- Mark your roster for the day
- Do it the same way every time
- · Always dismiss one at a time
- · Always ask them to verbally say 'Good bye'.
- · Always watch the student connect with the parent or guardian



- If you can get back into the teaching space, go back and double check that it is well cared for.
- Double check spaces where students could hide indoors
- Double check spaces where students could hide outdoors
- Double check your roster to be sure you checked everyone out

## STRATEGIC PRO COACH Be Genuine-Enhanced

- Sort of like enriched bread
- Show you are honestly excited about student progress
- · Slightly enhance the excitement for their benefit
- Show the consequences to them when they are not behaving well by dramatically rewarding preferred behavior.
