All programs require full tuition paid at time of application. A 75% refund is available for cancellations prior to March 31; 50% after that date until the Friday before your camp. There are no refunds 48 hours before your camp begins.

Please do not drop off your children before 8:15 a.m. or pick up after 4:15 p.m. There will be a \$10 late fee incurred for each child picked up after 4:15 p.m.

Aerospace FUNdamentals using LEGO 7-12 years \$350

This project-based camp, designed by Play-Well instructors, combines the basic format of our core engineering-themed programs based on the world of Minecraft. Students will explore real-world concepts in physics, engineering, and architecture while building their favorite Minecraft objects.

All Sports Camp – Li'l Mustangs 5-8 years \$300 7-14 years \$320

The Li'l Mustangs Camp introduces future athletes to the exciting world of team sports. During camp, young athletes will learn the fundamentals and game concepts of soccer, basketball, volleyball, baseball/softball, and other fun and exciting games! Our staff specializes in teaching fundamental motor movements and encourages athletes in finding intrinsic value in accomplishing a new skill. Our young athletes are supported in a safe and structured learning environment in which they can learn at an appropriate pace. Our priority is to ensure that each young athlete is having fun while learning! Everyday, the campers will be recognized for their hard work, good attitude, and skill improvement throughout camp.

Art Escapades 6-12 years \$350

All the world's a canvas when creating in the encouraging environment of Art Escapades. When it comes to the visual arts, there are not limitations to the young artist's imagination. Drawing in the lines or outside of the lines, purples skies or green dogs, unique jewelry and lopsided mugs are all options for making art with fellow campers. Campers will be taught individual interpretation through a variety of mediums. At the end of the week the campers will showcase their works in an afternoon art show celebrating their artistic creations. Come join the fun!

Basketball - Boys' 7-14 years \$300

The Dawson boys' basketball camps are designed to guide elementary to middle school athletes toward the fundamentals and team skills needed to enjoy and be successful at the game of basketball. We can help you get better! All skill levels are welcomed and we are equipped to challenge the most advanced of our players. Your athlete will get daily instruction and training in basketball fundamentals. They will also compete in game settings with teams set up by our coaches to challenge each player to improve at their team play. Our final day will conclude with individual challenges and prizes. We look forward to working with your athlete!

Basketball - Girls' 7-14 years \$300

This camp will focus on individual development of fundamental skills including correct shooting form, ball-handling, passing, defensive principles, as well as team offensive & defensive concepts. Each camper will learn drills that they can use at home to develop their individual skill set after camp is over. Every day of camp, there will be a focus word that relates to that particular camp day. Examples include: teamwork, hustle, work ethic, and fun! Particular words will be the focus of the day, and the counselors will pick a camper each day who exemplified the focus word. There will also be opportunities to play 5-on-5 and 3-on-3, as well as competitions in hot shot, free throws, and 1-on-1. Competitions will be divided into skill set, as to create an equal playing field for all. The goal of Dawson's girls' basketball camp is to create an environment of learning, as well as a space where players can ask questions and ultimately get better. Cartooning for Kids

8-12 years \$350

Do you enjoy reading comics and graphic novels? Do you also enjoy doodling, drawing and creating your own stories and jokes? Then Cartooning for Kids could be just the right camp for you! In this course, we will explore a variety of comic styles and techniques in an effort to produce our very own comic creations. Campers will experience different comic genres, as well as a variety of digital cartooning programs and apps. An emphasis will be placed on the planning, creation, and writing of comic stories and jokes. Reading, writing, and doodling are necessary components of this course, but the main focus will be to have fun! So come on and get animated with us at Cartooning for Kids!

Ceramics - Functional Dinnerware Workshop

11-18 years \$400

Campers will learn to work with clay on both the potter's wheel and in hand-building activities. On the wheel, students will learn the process of throwing a pot. They will learn to center their clay and will explore creating various forms including bowls, plates, cups, teapots, and vases. By contrast, hand-building projects give students a chance to create sculptures, jewelry boxes, and other forms that cannot be made on the wheel. While both sessions will allow campers opportunities to explore a variety of forms, the sessions' firing techniques and products will be different. All clay, tools, glaze and other decorative materials are included in the cost of the camp.

Challenge Course

12-16 years \$425

This summer come and learn on our brand new Challenge Course Adventure Camp. Located on the Dawson School campus. This will be a highly active and engaging educational experience designed to cultivate character and challenge students to self-reflect in powerful and meaningful ways. Students will spend the bulk of their week engaged in activities on the newly constructed Dawson Challenge Rope Course!

A rope course is a challenging outdoor experience that encompasses personal development and team building through a series of activities on a high and low rope course. Low ropes will take place on the ground or only a few feet about off the ground. High ropes will take places off the ground in heights of tree levels or as high as telephone polls.

Through group initiative projects and personal investigation, students will explore and practice such concepts as responsible risk-taking, finding meaning in failure, deep listening, and effective cooperation. Students will be invited to "venture" out of their comfort zone in a variety of contexts, explore their boundaries, and develop a deeper sense of self-knowledge and self-awareness. Students will realize and sharpen important skills such as resilience, endurance, self-discipline, leadership, and many more developmental skills that will help them in life's challenges.

Cheerleading

7-12 years \$300

This AMAZING Cheerleading camp will help teach young athletes the essential skills to lead crowds and support the home team! This cheer program ensures that each camper learns cheers, proper hand and body movements, and jumping techniques. There will be basic stunting and tumbling skills taught during the camp as well! Although learning the basics will be the main focus of the camp our goal will be to have fun while each cheerleader learns important life skills such as teambuilding and leadership. Fun "cheer" crafts will be made throughout the week for keepsakes. The week concludes with a choreographed performance that the kids will be learning throughout the week.

Creative Writing (June 12-16)

10-14 years \$350

This camp is designed for young authors (10-14 years old) who are excited to flex their creative muscles as they explore fiction writing. Campers will spend a few hours of each day engaged in writing: reading models, responding to prompts, sharing their work with others, and revising what they've created. Those activities will be interspersed with games designed to spark creative thinking and develop vocabulary or writing skills, as well as time outside to play and visit the pool. At the end of the week, campers will publish some of their work for sharing.

Note: This camp is not intended to make children better at academic writing; it's not designed for remediation. Campers should come with a love of creative expression and the ability to do some self-directed writing for extended periods of time.

Creative Writing (June 19-23)

10-14 years \$350

This camp is designed for young authors (10-14 years old) who are enthusiastic about creative writing, specifically poetry and other performance pieces, like monologues and plays. Campers will spend a few hours of each day engaged in writing: reading and listening to models, responding to prompts, sharing their work with others, and revising what they've created. Those activities will be interspersed with games designed to spark creative thinking and develop vocabulary or writing skills, as well as time outside to play and visit the pool. At the end of the week, campers will share some of their pieces in a coffee-house style reading.

Note: This camp is not intended to make children better at academic writing; it's not designed for remediation. Campers should come with a love of creative expression and the ability to do some self-directed writing for extended periods of time.

Creative Writing (June 26-30)

7-10 years \$350

Where Imaginations Run Wild! The Dawson Creative Writing Camp is designed to guide students through the process of organizing thoughts, picking topics, planning, writing for different purposes, and publishing work. Student authors will create narrative, expository, and persuasive works, experiment with poetry, increase vocabulary, and share their creations with other young writers. Participants will gain confidence as authors as they incorporate writing practices that enhance their creativity in the academic setting and throughout their lives. Parents and friends will be invited to share in a writers' cafe at the end of the week.

Farm to Table

11-18 years \$350

The farm to table camp explores our connection with the food we eat and the individuals who are responsible for supplying it. Together, we will explore our food system by planting and harvesting food from the garden as well as learning about the various techniques and skills necessary to keep a garden vibrant. We will work in the garden most mornings and participate in various "farm to table" activities in the afternoon such as visiting local farms and markets, and learning about meal planning and food preparation. This week-long camp culminates in a farm to table dinner which campers will prepare and host for their parents and siblings.

Flag Football

7-12 years \$300

Welcome to the Mustang Flag Football Experience! This is a weeklong camp for children between the ages of 6 to 12 years of age. It is designed for kids of all athletic abilities; from the experienced athlete to the child who is curious and always wanted to learn the game of football. You will be taught by variety of coaches in a highly energetic and encouraging atmosphere. Skills that will be taught will be: how to properly block, receive, pass, play defense and most importantly, learn how to unite as a team. During the beginning of the week all the athletes will be broken into teams. In these teams, the athletes will learn through participation of running routes, agility drills, and game scenarios. At the end of the week all the teams will play in a tournament style format for the "Mustang Championship"!

Food Explorers

9-12 years \$350

This camp will explore the exciting world of food. We all love it, but how much do we really know about where our food comes from? Food Explorers examines how and where we get food, healthy eating, gardening practices, conventional cooking with a focus on safety, making a solar oven, and designing creative recipes. This camp allows kids to have fun with food while taking a hands-on approach to learning.

French Camp

7-14 years \$350

It is time to give your child a lifelong opportunity to become a Francophile (francophone culture lover). Through movies, readings, storytelling, cartoons, crafts, role-play and songs, your child will learn French and discover language and cultural characteristics about France and francophone countries in the world. Each geography, music, and way of life for francophone countries is unique, and students will travel across continents to learn the vast influence of these French-centered cultures.

Jedi Master Engineering using LEGO

7-12 years \$350

The Force Awakens in this advanced engineering course for young Jedi! Discover key engineering concepts such as gear trains, worm drives, pneumatics, and eccentric motion. Build LEGO X-Wings, AT-AT walkers, Pod Racers, Star Destroyers, Cloud Cities, Settlements, Fortresses, and other complex machines and structures from a galaxy far, far away.

Jewelry Making

12-18 years \$420

Students will have the opportunity to create silver rings, ear rings and necklaces. This class will cover all the elements of basic jewelry making. Students will learn the “lost” art of wax casting: a method developed in Ancient Egypt. The lost wax casting process involves creating a wax model which is then suspended in a metal flask. A plaster-like material called investment is poured over the model. The invested flask is then placed in a kiln, and the wax model is slowly melted out until only the negative cavity, the exact shape of the original, remains. Molten metal (silver) is then vacuumed into this negative space and allowed to cool and solidify. The metal piece is removed from the plaster. Sprues (the bump at the opening where the molten metal was poured into the mold) are cut and ground. Various polishing media are used to bring the piece to its final polished state. Students will also be introduced to advanced techniques (Stone setting (Bezel and Gypsy) and Enameling (Enameling is the process of fusing powdered glass to metal).

Jr. Adventure

5-7 years \$300

Summer is a time when children can embrace the joy of being a kid. Junior Adventure Camp offers a safe, structured program in which campers make friends, learn life skills, experience teamwork, and just have some “PLAIN ’OLE” FUN. During the day, campers will be involved in the following activities: casual outdoor games, playground time, skits, story time, nature appreciation, swimming, song and dance, and arts and crafts. Campers will be evaluated as to swimming ability and will be strictly regulated according to their ability in the pool. Camp size will be limited in order to maintain a low camper-to-counselor ratio.

WHAT WE DO FOR FUN . . .

SWIMMING: You can't have summer without cooling off in the pool! Your child will learn underwater safety rules while building confidence with beginning swim playtime. **GAMES:** From outdoor to singing games, the kids will have fun and learn how to work as a team.

NATURE DISCOVERY: Campers discover lots of interesting things while enjoying nature walks on campus. Last year they discovered an apple tree to snack on!

OBSTACLE COURSE: A challenging but fun course helps campers work on teamwork skills and confidence.
